

**More information about our new online course:
Care and Storage of Historical Objects with Kathy Craughwell Varda.**

The course will begin on July 23 (the original in-person workshop date) - and will span 6 weeks, ending on August 27. Learning will take place via Google Classroom.

- During weeks 1 and 2, participants will login to Google Classroom and watch a video lesson that Kathy has filmed. Each lesson will be about 10 minutes long. After the lesson, there will be a short assignment to complete and upload to the classroom. Registrants will need access to their museum collections to complete these assignments.
- In week 3, there will be a 30 minute Zoom meeting for Kathy to check in and a live Q&A session.
- Weeks 4 and 5 will repeat the process of a video lesson and an assignment.
- Week 6 will have a final wrap-up 30 minute Zoom session.
- Additional resources and other materials will be shared throughout. The assignment each week should take you between 30 minutes to 1 hour, depending on the assignment and registrant's own work pace.

While this online class was designed for a way to adapt the in-person workshop to an online environment - it does have advantages over a one time workshop session. Namely, registrants will be working in their museum collections, making small but concrete improvements on a weekly basis. Registrants will also have access to Kathy and her knowledge for a six week period - and will be able to ask questions as you go, which is a more helpful model as some questions only arise when you're in the midst of working, long after a workshop session is over.

Google Classroom is free and fairly intuitive to understand. After you register, you will receive a code to log in to the specific class via email from GHHN along with additional information. GHHN will also create a how-to video to help navigate Google Classroom - and we are always available to help with any technical questions you might have. Even if participating in an online class is not something you've done before - if you can watch videos online and attach files to emails, you can successfully participate in this class! And if you haven't yet mastered those skills - we can teach you!
